DIRECTIONS TO TEST LOCATION:

From Birmingham: Travel North on I-65 and take exit onto I-565 East toward Huntsville. Take exit 19A for Hwy 431 South/Governor's Drive. Drive about 17 miles to New Hope. At the traffic light after Piggly Wiggly turn left onto Main Drive. Go one mile and turn right onto City Park Road.

From Chattanooga: Take I-24 W toward NASHVILLE/BIRMINGHAM (Passing through GEORGIA, then crossing into TENNESSEE). Take the US-64/US-72 exit, (EXIT 152), toward SOUTH PITTSBURG. Turn RIGHT onto US-72 W. Continue on US-72 W (Crossing into ALABAMA). US 72 will turn into I565 West. Take exit at 19A for Hwy 431 South/Governor's Drive. Drive about 17 miles to New Hope. Fast CAT is open to all dogs 12 months of age or older that are individually registered/listed with the AKC registration as Purebreds, Foundation Stock Service (FSS) dogs, Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) dogs and AKC Canine Partner.

Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test, and in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded.

FAST CAT TESTS CHECK IN

Check In is the time when participants are expected to go to the registration table.
For inspection for fitness, lameness or "in season" females

TEST HOURS: 8:00 am CST until completed.

ROLL CALL Check in will be ½ hour before your block. Check-in/roll call ends at 1:00pm on day of event. We will be running the dogs in time blocks, so you will be able to get both runs in the same block. We can adjust the run time for second runs to allow for cooling down dogs.

Lunch break 12-1 pm daily

You will be expected to have complete info for your dog.
Incomplete entries WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

FAST CAT

The FAST CAT is a timed straight race of 100 yards where a dog chases a lure. Dogs are run singularly and earn points based on their handicapped speed. There are no placements. Titles are issued at designated benchmarks. The dog's time to complete the 100-yard dash is converted into MPH. Dogs earn points based on their handicapped speed. A handicap system is applied to a dog's MPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:

- 18" or greater = handicap is 1.0
- 12" up to less than 18" = handicap is 1.5
- Below 12" = handicap is 2.0

Points = MPH multiplied by the dog's handicap

Titles are earned by accumulating points. The following titles will be awarded:

BCAT = 150 points
DCAT = 500 points
FCAT = 1,000 points
FCAT# = every additional 500 points.

ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNERS SOLE RISK

- All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.
- Each dog requires an entry form
- Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures, or the "Agreement" found on the Official AKC Entry Form
- Dogs may wear any collar **EXCEPT** a choker collar, a collar with prongs or an electronic training collar.
- Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused. Entries will be refunded
- Mixed breeds must be spayed or neutered to be eligible to run. AKC registered dogs with breed disqualifications may be entered.
- Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength.
- Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test, and in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded
- Battery powered; continuous loop equipment will be used. Lures consist of white plastic. Electronic timing system will be used with manual timing as a backup.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- The handler may NOT run down the course to entice the dog to run or use toys/treats to get the dog to run. They CAN call their dog from the catch area.
- The Huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve a testing dog.
- Persons exhibit conduct detrimental to the AKC/NKC/any dog(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the test site.
- Bring your own shade
- No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.
- The event-hosting club, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc, assume no liability or responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event.

TIPS FOR HANDLERS

1. The outer field is mostly fenced. It is strongly recommended that prior to running your dog, you have good "recall" control over your dog, as the dogs will be running off-leash in an enclosed fence line for the 100 yards and catch area.
2. Handlers should wear comfortable shoes and be physically able to hold and release their dogs or catch them.
3. Dogs will be brought to the start line on a leash and released only upon a verbal signal ("Tally-Ho!") from the Huntmaster. Dogs may be released by hand, folded leash, or using a traditional lure coursing slip lead.
4. **The handler may choose to release or catch their dog. If the handler releases their dog, they should have someone familiar with the dog at the end of the course to retrieve the dog. If the handler chooses to catch their dog, they should have someone else release their dog at the start line. The catcher is expected to promptly secure the dog and leave the field with the dog on a leash.**
5. Handlers are advised to warm up their dogs prior to their run and walk them for about 10 minutes afterward.
6. Any person, upon reasonable complaint, may be asked to leave the grounds of the test by the Field Committee and may be disciplined by the AKC. Children must always be supervised by their parents or guardian(s).
7. If you are releasing your dog, please have a catcher down at the catch area when there are 5-6 dogs ahead of you at the releasing point.

Neither Huntsville Obedience Training Club, nor its members, will be responsible for any accidents at this test.

Fun runs are offered for \$5.00 per run, limit one (1) run per test event. The net proceeds from Fun Runs will be donated to the Ark Animal Rescue.
